An Analysis of

Taiwan's Fastener Trade in H1 2017

Continuous Growth in Export to USA/Germany/ Netherlands/Japan and Extended Reach to Newly **Emerging Markets** by Gang Hao Chang, Fastener World

aiwanese fastener industry has been confronted by slightly increasing challenges since the EU announced the demise of its antidumping & countervailing measures against certain iron & steel and stainless steel fasteners originating in China in 2016 and 2017 respectively, which then forced many Taiwanese fastener suppliers, who only traded with certain markets before, to face up to the existence of new or potential competitors and start thinking how they should extend their reach to different markets (e.g. extending reach to the "direct-users" market in various industries, OEM/ODM, low volume & high variety production, specialty products, make-to-order, focus more on marketing approaches, R&D of new materials for fastening technology and application, etc.) in order to face possible challenges in the future.

According to the statistics for Taiwan's fastener trade in H1 2017, it reveals that Taiwanese fastener companies have in recent years gradually extended their reach to many countries that show substantial fastener demand caused by domestic industrial investment projects, in addition to existing clients they have been collaborating with for years. Some of these countries have already become the top 20 trade partners of Taiwan, showing the fact that Taiwanese fastener companies could not only maintain relations with existing clients from Europe/USA/Japan, but could also reinforce collaboration with those in other newly emerging countries.

The article will expound upon the development trend of Taiwanese fastener industry based on the import/export statistics released by TCA for the first half (H1) of 2017.

In H1 2017, Taiwan exported around 740,000 tons of fasteners to the world and imported around 8,374 tons of fasteners from the world. If calculated by USD, Taiwan exported around US\$ 1.934 billion worth of fasteners to the world and imported around US\$ 67 million worth of fasteners from the world. There appears a significant difference between the export and the import. Compared to the data

in 2016, Taiwan exported more fasteners to the

world in H1 2017 (either calculated by value

or weight); however, its import value or weight

was distinctly on the decline.

Export

The tables (1a. and 1b.) show the top 20 fastener export destinations of Taiwan. Either in the table for export weight or in the table for export value, the top 5 fastener export trade partners of Taiwan were: USA, Germany, the Netherlands, Japan and UK (These five countries represented more than 60% of Taiwan's total fastener export). Except that the export to UK calculated by weight showed a slight drop, the exports to other top 4 countries all showed significant growth compared to the same period of 2016.

We could observe from the top 20 list that Taiwan also exported some large proportions of fasteners to Mexico, China, Thailand, Russia, Vietnam and India, where the investment activities have currently become vibrant. The authorities of these countries are active in developing their own automotive, railway or infrastructure industries (e.g. China's "One Belt One Road" Initiative, increasing investments from foreign carmakers in Mexico or the planned high speed rail construction of Thailand), and these industries could help generate substantial fastener demand in the end. It would also be lucky for Taiwan as the fastener categories demanded by these industries have also been the major strengths and main focus of Taiwanese fastener industry in recent years. Due to these reasons, many Taiwanese companies have started to extend their reach to these new markets and many foreign buyers are also willing to place their orders to Taiwan.

Compared to the same period of 2016, the weight and value of fasteners Taiwan exported to Mexico, China, Russia or India both showed increase, except for Thailand and Vietnam showing a downward trend. The drop in exports to Thailand and Vietnam might be somehow related to the

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political instability or stricter environmental protection policies in the region. However, it'll take some time to explore the real cause.

Amongst the top 20, USA showed the highest increase in export weight compared to the data in 2016, while UK showed the most significant drop. If calculated by value, the export to USA still showed the highest increase compared to the data in 2016, while the exports to Australia and Italy both showed a drop.

Import

The tables (2a. and 2b.) show the top 20 fastener import origins of Taiwan in H1 2017. If calculated by import weight, the top 5 fastener import origins of Taiwan in H1 2017 were: Japan, China, Vietnam, S. Korea and Germany (These 5 countries represented more than 70% of Taiwan's total fastener import). If calculated by import value, the top 5 fastener import origins of Taiwan were: Japan, USA, Germany, China and S. Korea (These 5 countries also represented more than 70% of Taiwan's total fastener import). Compared to the data in 2016, the weights and values of fasteners Taiwan imported from Japan, China and Vietnam all showed a drop; however, the weights and values of fasteners Taiwan imported from S. Korea and Germany both showed growth. As for the import from USA, it showed growth in weight, but showed a decline in value. Compared to the same period of 2016, the weight and value of fasteners Taiwan imported from the whole world were both on the decline.

In terms of import weight, the import from China showed the most significant drop and S. Korea showed the most significant increase. If calculated by import value, USA showed the most significant drop and S. Korea still showed the most significant increase. This may be a message that Taiwan reinforced its fastener purchase from S. Korea in H1 2017.

Conclusion

With the upcoming yearend of 2017, the optimistic expectations of several industry leaders toward 2018 and the business opportunities Fastener Fair Stuttgart and

International Fastener Expo held this year may bring to exhibitors, fasteners Taiwan exported to Europe/USA/Japan with great fastener demand are expected to maintain strong growth and the export to other newly emerging countries in Latin America and Southeast Asia is also expected to demonstrate better performance.

Looking forward, Taiwanese fastener companies will also face challenges below:

- 1. Appreciation of NTD- Euro, Japanese Yen and many other currencies all demonstrated significant depreciation. NTD, on the contrary, has appreciated a lot, which may influence the order intakes and profit margins of many companies.
- 2. The new labor law in Taiwan- This new law is reported to have caused a nearly 10% increase in the labor cost of many companies in Taiwan. In addition, more day-offs for employees have also resulted in the lack of labor force, which makes many companies extend their lead time.
- 3. Hiking cost due to environmental protection policies- Some fastener companies pointed out that the cost for being compliant with all environmental protection policies set for the fastener supply chain has increased a lot and the electroplating and heat treating cost in Taiwan has been very close to that in Europe, USA and Japan. The delay in product delivery could be a serious problem.
- 4. Insufficient labor force- Due to more day-offs for employees, fastener companies cannot help but introduce more automated machines and facilities to handle the issue of delayed product delivery.
